SEWING

METHODS BY WHICH GROUPS OF SINGLE LEAVES OR FOLDS
JOIN TOGETHER TO FORM A BOOK-BLOCK
BY ATTACHING EITHER
TO EACH OTHER OR
TO A COMMON SUPPORT OR
TO BOTH

BASIC STITCHES

LAP STITCH - A RUNNING SLIP STITCH
PASSES OVER A SUPPORT OR UNDER THE PREVIOUS SEWING
EXITS - NEAR SIDE (BACKWARD)
ENTERS - FAR SIDE (FORWARD)
QUICK, BUT NOT SECURE

LOOP STITCH - A LOCKING STITCH
PASSES AROUND A SUPPORT OR THE PREVIOUS SEWING
EXITS - FAR SIDE (FORWARD)
ENTERS - NEAR SIDE (BACKWARD)
SECURE, BUT SLOW

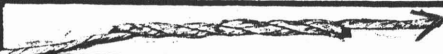
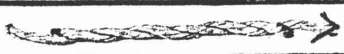
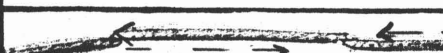
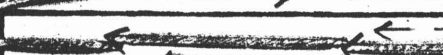
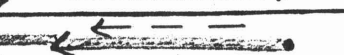
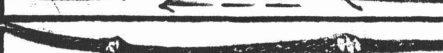
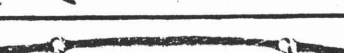
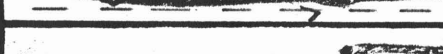
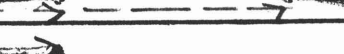
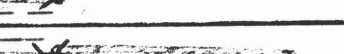
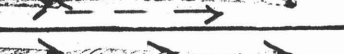
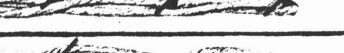
LINK STITCH - DROPS DOWN TO ATTACH TO THE PREVIOUS SECTIONS

SPAN STITCH - CLIMBS UP TO ATTACH TO THE NEXT SECTION

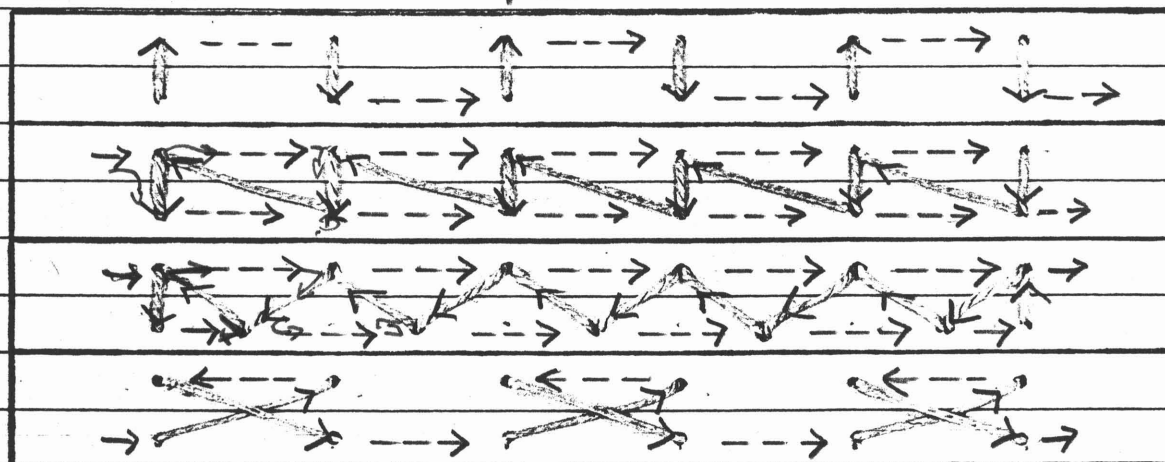
KETTLE STITCH - LINKS DOWN & SPANS UP
