Stages of Papermaking

Before:

Fiber Selection: Bast, leaf, grass, recycled materials

Fiber Preparation:

Prior to cooking (harvesting raw fibers, cutting fiber to length, fermentation, sunbleaching steaming and stripping bast fiber, presoaking)

Cooking (lime, soda ash, lye)

Rinsing

Beating (wooden mallets, blender, stamper, hollander beater)

During:

Fiber/water ratio in vat

Mould & Deckle type used for sheetforming(wove, laid, deckle box)

Sheetforming

Couching (surface texture of material couched on, double couching)

Pressing (hand pressure, vacuum, hydraulic press)

After:

Drying (air dried, dried singly, dried in groups, restraint dried)


