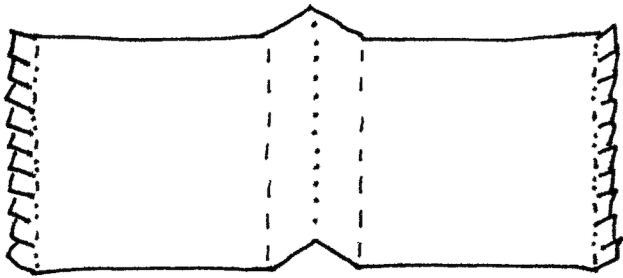
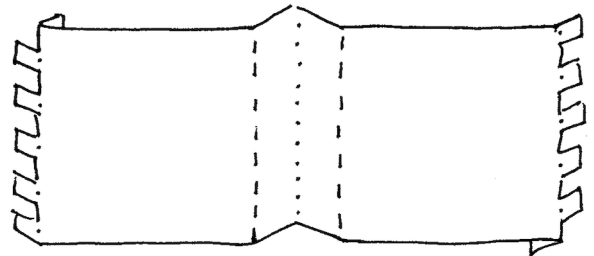
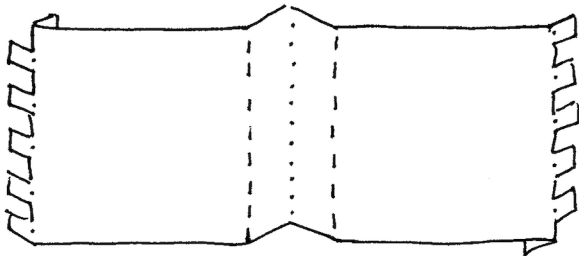


Tabbed Carousel Construction

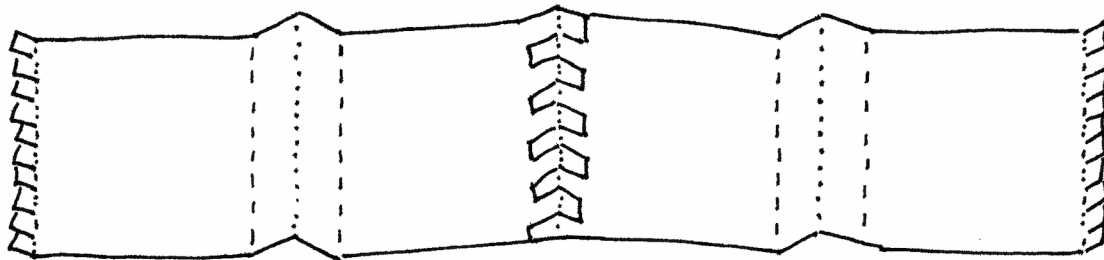

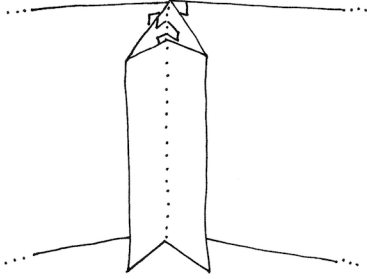
The dimensions of the panels and the columns can be any desired size or proportion. There must be tabs at each end of the sheet of at least $\frac{1}{2}$ inch. The tabs can be any width I prefer an even number of tabs. Starting with the first tab on the upper left, place a small length of double-sided tape on the front of the tab and continue placing the tape on every other tab of the left side. Repeat on the right side but start with the second tab and repeat for every other tab. Repeat for all the sheets to be attached.



Fold the tabs with tape to the back. Lace the remaining tabs together to attach one sheet to the next sheet. Using waste sheets isolate the tabs and glue them to the opposite sheet with PVA.



Repeat with all sheets to be attached. Fold up and align fore edge and spine. Press Before continuing. After pressing pop-ups may be inserted.



To finish, release the double-sided tape and fasten the segments to each other to form a solid spine.



Covers are drummed on to the front and back segments. Magnets can be inserted into the boards before covering with cloth or paper. Cloth tapes can be used to pull the magnets apart. Tabs are glued to the cover boards, the tabs may need to be made longer than those used in the interior.
