2016 Scholarship Application

GBW offers scholarships to attend the Standards of Excellence in Hand Bookbinding Seminar to people for whom attendance would create a financial hardship. Scholarships are available for both student and regular members. Non-members may apply, but are required to become a member prior to attending the Seminar (go to www.guildofbookworkers.org/members). The scholarship consists of a waiver of registration fees to the Seminar, lodging costs for four nights at the conference hotel and the banquet (does not include any tours). This

is for lodging only and does not include hotel parking, phone calls, movie rentals, or any other room service. Make a short statement explaining why the scholarship is needed, obtain two brief letters of reference, and send them with a completed application form to the Scholarship Committee at the address below. Recipients are responsible for making their own travel plans. After scholarships are awarded GBW treasurer will contact recipients to discuss lodging arrangements.
